
Invitation to Bid – Catoosa County Mowing & Hay Removal

The Catoosa County Board of Commissioners hereby solicits and requests sealed bids for the purchase of rights to mow and harvest hay from an approximately 22.5-acre property as described further in the Bid Documents on the County Website.

Contractor must have minimum Worker's Comp and General Liability Insurance in full force and effect. No Bid will be considered unless it is accompanied by satisfactory evidence that the Bidder holds any and all necessary or required Federal, State or local licenses and/or permits. Pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 13-10-91, all contractors and sub-contractors performing work within the State of Georgia on a contract with a public employer must register and participate in a federal work authorization. Catoosa County will require certification for contractor that this requirement has been met. Each Respondent shall submit with its Bid a copy of current Business License &/or Occupational Tax Certificate issued in Georgia (Farm/Agricultural Operations are exempt from this requirement). If bidder cannot provide this License, it will be required to obtain one from Catoosa County if it is the Awarded Respondent. Qualifications of the Bidder will be reviewed before the Award of the Contract.

Original Bid + two copies (3 total) must be SEALED and delivered in person or by mail to the office of the Board of Commissioners, Catoosa County Government Building, 800 LaFayette Street, Ringgold, GA 30736, Attention: Christal Thomas, Projects Administrator, not later than 2:00 p.m. EST Friday, July 21, 2017. The envelope shall state "SEALED BID – MOWING & HAY REMOVAL" to prevent accidental opening. Any Bid received after this time will not be considered. The Bids will be publicly opened and read at 2:05 p.m. Friday, July 21, 2017 at the Catoosa County Government Building, 800 LaFayette Street, Ringgold, Georgia.
